If you are our customer and you need a repair, you can raise an appointment with us through myAccount, without needing to wait on the phone. Depending on your tenancy type, you can raise a repair for your home and/or a communal area (see guide below).


Once we have received your repair request, our contractor will contact you to book an appointment that is convenient for you. This guide will take you through the simple steps of raising a repair using myAccount.

Raise a repair:

1. From your device, navigate to myAccount - https://orbitcustomerhub.org.uk/myaccount/

2. Log in by selecting the 'Login' button and entering your username (email address) and password.



3. Once you have logged into myAccount using your username and password, you will arrive at the home page. To raise a repair, navigate to the second column, 'My Repairs':



4. To raise a new repair, select the '**Raise a repair'** button towards the bottom of the '**My Repairs'** column. (If you have already raised the repair and wish to view an open repair request, select 'View open repairs').








5. This will present you with a list of address options. From here, you can select your property address (for repairs to your property) or a communal address (for repairs to a communal/public area).

6. You will then be given the option to agree to the use of functional cookies. To agree and continue with your repair request, select 'Continue'.

8. Once you have selected a topic, you can then choose the item or area that needs repairing. For example, the repair of a faulty light switch can be raised under 'light switch'.

You can make your selection by either selecting the item or area from the list (shown on the left-hand side of the screen), or by choosing the option from the images (shown on the right-hand side of the screen).

9. You will then be asked a series of questions related to the repair. This will help the contractor prepare for their visit. You may be asked to respond by typing in text, or by selecting an option from a list. It is important that all your responses are accurate and include as much detail as possible.

If you wish to change your response at any stage, you can select the 'Go back' option. If you do not require the repair any longer, you can cancel your repair request by selecting 'Cancel request'.



10. Once all information has been provided, you will be asked to upload a photo. Whether you wish to upload an image or not, please select 'Continue' at this stage.







11. You can then decide whether to upload an image of the item or area needing the repair. This is optional, but the information you provide will help the contractor assess what work is required, and how complex it might be. This will affect how long the work takes, and the number of visits that the contractor will have to make. They will discuss this with you when they contact you to book the appointment.

- Selecting 'Yes' will give you the option to upload a photograph from your device.
- Selecting 'No' will allow you to skip this option.


